Regional Map Identifying Colossæ

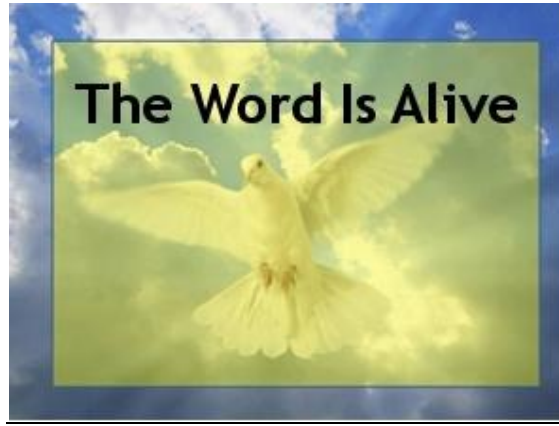
