Paul wanted Titus to join him in Nicopolis on the mainland of Greece, where he intended to spend the winter months.

## God and Christ as “Our Saviour” in Titus

The chart shows the references that Paul makes to both God the Father and God the Son as the Saviour.

In due time he revealed his word through the proclamation with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Saviour. (Titus 1:3)	Grace and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Saviour.  (Titus 1:4b)
Not to pilfer, but to show complete and perfect fidelity, so that in everything they may be an ornament to the doctrine of God our Saviour. (Titus 2:10)	While we wait for the blessed hope and the manifestation of the glory of our great God and Saviour, Jesus Christ.  (Titus 2:13)
But when the goodness and loving-kindness of God our Saviour appeared. (Titus 3:4)	This Spirit he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Saviour.  (Titus 3:6)

Note that the pairings appear in each of the three chapters. However, the subdivision of the document was added a long time after Paul wrote the letters of course!
